# CID/SID PASTOR'S CONFERENCE

"Engaging Unbelief: The Proper Distinction between Apologetics and Protreptics."

Rev. Dr. Kirk Clayton, a Fellow of the International Academy of Apologetics, Evangelism, and Human Rights in studied Strasbourg France. has with John apologetics Warwick Montgomery, Craig Parton, Paul Copan, Gene Edward Veith, Donald Williams, and other. In 2022 he presented a major thesis for the Academy on the topic of the reliability of Scripture. Dr. Clayton specializes in fostering new apologetic responses to the current questions and challenges being posed to Christianity. After 24 years serving as a parish pastor, Dr. Clayton will begin serving as an Assistant Professor of Theology at Concordia University in Chicago this fall, where he will be teaching courses on Christian doctrine.



Rev. Dr. Chad Kendall, is the Assistant Vice President for Mission & Identity at Concordia University Chicago. He also serves as Assistant Professor of Theology. Rev. Dr. Kendall came to Concordia-Chicago from St. John Lutheran Church in Wheaton, IL where he served as a pastor. Prior to that, he was a pastor in Indiana for 12 years and in Iowa for six years. Kendall graduated from Bradley University in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management and Administration. He graduated from Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne in 2002. He completed his doctoral missiology degree in at Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne. Kendall is currently the chair of the LCMS Northern Illinois District taskforce on multiethnic mission and ministry.
